Flip the Script is a program developed by a psychologist who spent a decade studying sexual violence in Canadian

high schools and universities. Flip the Script is proven to cut the rate of sexual violence in young women by more than half. It isn't a self-defence course, rather, the program uses the best available research on acquaintance rape and perpetrator tactics to teach young women about the real risk of sexual assault and how to spot early warning signs in men they know. The program empowers young women to trust their instincts and act quickly to keep themselves safe. Follow-up research shows that women who take the program can act quickly under pressure and avoid 'freezing'.

The North Shore Women's Centre is pleased to offer Flip the Script to girls aged 16-20. More information on workshops is available on the North Shore Women's Centre website.
