Message from the Wentworth Health Centre: Increase of Illness at Wentworth

We are seeing an influx of illness at school this week and

would like to remind parents/guardians that if your child becomes sick at school, or arrives at school with flu-like symptoms, a parent/guardian will be contacted and asked to pick the child up as soon as possible. The Collingwood Health Centre is unable to accommodate students for an extended period of time. Parents/Guardians are asked to arrange for pick up in a timely manner, if you are unable to pick up your child within a 30-minute window, please have an emergency contact on file that can get to the school within that time frame.

If your child has a fever (temperature of 37.5C and above),

diarrhea, vomiting, or excessive coughing please keep them at home and let the school nurses know of their symptoms. Students must stay home for a minimum of 24 hours following fever, vomiting and/or diarrhea and without the use of medication.
