Message from the Head of Wentworth

Dear Wentworth Families.

Thank you for your patience and flexibility during the past week of inclement weather. Generally, the drop-off and pick-up at the front traffic circle has been flowing well. However, we continue to experience traffic challenges on Chairlift Road north of the school, at and around the roundabout and drop-off area.

For the safety of our children, and to ease the flow of traffic, we would like to highlight some important traffic reminders:

The curb area on Chairlift Road immediately beyond the roundabout is a NO STOPPING/NO PARKING zone. This area is marked off by cones.

The curb area immediately beyond the NO STOPPING/NO PARKING zone is a DROP OFF ONLY zone. When parked in the DROP OFF ONLY


- zone, drivers are required to remain in their vehicles. • When parking on Chairlift to walk your child into the school, park around the corner further up Chairlift well beyond the DROP OFF ONLY zone. Always be respectful of our neighbor's and do not
- should not be used as turn rounds or drop off points. · Please do not turn around when traveling up or down Chairlift Road. This causes significant delays and is a safety concern.

- When driving down Chairlift Road, do not stop to drop off children on the west or north side of the street (drop off is restricted to the school side of the road only). Please be sure that only the marked cross walk is used when children are crossing the road at the back of the school.
