Considerations:

A. Core Academic Courses (required):

- English Studies 12 *or* AP English Language and Composition 12
- Career Life Connections (taught during FLEX and Collingwood U; registration not required)
- To meet graduation requirements, students must have completed at least one course at the Grade 11 or 12 level in Mathematics, Science and Social Studies; at least one course in STEM or the Arts in Grade 10, 11 or 12; and Physical and Health Education 10.

B. Course Selections

- Grade 12 students must be enrolled in **8 courses, plus Career-Life Connections**
- **One** course is pre-selected: Grade 12 Study (H Block/Collingwood U)
- Select **one** English option between English Studies 12 and AP English Language & Composition (includes credit for English Studies 12)
- Select **six** additional academic, fine arts or applied skills courses, ensuring you are meeting the graduation requirements and university prerequisites as per your course selection meeting with University Guidance.
