More than a dozen University of California field hockey players were honoured for their outstanding efforts in the classroom this fall, as 15 Golden Bears collected

America East Honour Roll laurels. Six members of the squad -- Maddie Cleat, Natalie Dalton (Collingwood School class of 2017), Fionna Jensen, Janaye Sakkas, Victoria Struys and Alie Zimmer -- also earned a spot on the prestigious Commissioner's Honour Roll, which awards members of the conference who notched a 3.5 grade point average or better during the Fall 2017 semester.

Following the completion of each semester, the Atlantic 10 Conference honours select student-athletes with Commissioner's Honour Roll Distinction. To be listed on the Commissioner's Honour Roll, a student-athlete in an Atlantic 10-sponsored sport must have a 3.5 GPA or better (on a 4.0 scale) during the specified semester. Freshmen are eligible to receive the award.
